

RECYCLING OF OIL, ANTI-FREEZE AND BATTERIES

The Coldwater Board of Public Utilities is doing its part to protect our environment by making it easy for Branch County residents to recycle their used oil, oil filters, anti-freeze and household batteries. These items are all accepted at the Wastewater Treatment Plant, 100 Jay Street, during the following times: Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m.; and Saturday, Sunday and holidays from 8:30 a.m. until 4:00 p.m.

Hazardous liquids or gasoline mixtures are not accepted. Oil or antifreeze must not be contaminated with paints, thinners, brake fluid, gasoline, etc.

Household batteries are also collected at Wal-Mart, Culy's Jewelry and the Henry L. Brown Municipal Building.
