

CITY OF COLDWATER RESIDENTIAL RECYCLING PROGRAM

Reliable Disposal will pick up recyclable materials every other week within the City of Coldwater. The recycling bins are the property of the City of Coldwater and must be returned when your disposal service is canceled. An extra fee will be charged to your account if the recycling bin is not returned along with your toter (the current fee is \$10 per recycling bin).

Recycling must be out by 7:00 a.m. Paper products must be kept separate from the plastic, glass and metal when placing the material at the curb. Please remember to rinse out your containers before placing them in the recycling bins. Do not place garbage in the recycling bins; also, do not place your recyclables in plastic bags, as plastic bags are not recyclable.

Items that can be recycled include:

- Newspaper, including all inserts.
- Box board [cereal and cracker boxes (please remove liners) and shoe boxes] – No pizza boxes.
- Magazines
- Catalogs
- Flattened corrugated boxes no larger than 2' x 3' are accepted. Please place beside the recycling container.
- Mixed paper and junk mail (includes letters, copies, flyers, loose-leaf paper, envelopes, file folders, but not the following: thermal fax paper, carbon paper, Tyvek plastic envelopes, tissues, Styrofoam, paper napkins and cups).
- Glass bottles and jars in all colors (no Pyrex, light bulbs, window glass, drinking glasses, decorative glass or ceramics).
- Metal food containers: cans, lids, caps and clean aluminum trays, pie tins and foil.
- Plastic jugs and bottles (clear or colored) from beverages, laundry and hair care products with #1 or #2 on the bottom. Only small-mouth containers (no tubs, buckets, bags or lids) and no oil product containers.
