When setting a HUD mobile home or premanufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service, feeder and a final inspection.

All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. <b>No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.</b> The telephone number for the inspector will be provided on the permit form. <b>When ready for an inspection, call the inspector providing as much advance notice as possible. <p><b>Expiration of Permit:</b> A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 after the time of commencing the work.</p>
