EROSION CONTROL SITE PLAN

Per the State of Michigan, Department of Environmental Quality and the City of Coldwater Soil Erosion and Sedimentation Control Ordinance a completed erosion control plan must be turned in with all applications for permit review. Please see the SESC Program Guide for all erosion control plan requirements.

SOIL EROSION PERMIT FEES

All fees shall be paid at time of completion of the permit application. For the City of Coldwater the SE permit fees are \$10 per acre.

PERFORMANCE GUARANTEE

A performance guarantee on top of the permit fee is required for all SE projects. Bonds will be accepted in the form of cash, certified check, or irrevocable bank letter of credit (bond) and shall extend for the duration of the permit (until project completion) Please contact the City of Coldwater for further information, including performance guarantee amounts

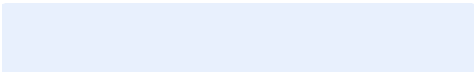
