

Appliance Recycling Frequently Asked Questions

Which appliances can be recycled?

Answer: You may recycle up to two refrigerators, freezers, room air conditioners, or dehumidifiers.

How much is the incentive for recycling my appliance?

Answer: \$50 for refrigerators and freezers. (\$25 for room air-conditioning units and dehumidifiers. These have to be picked up with a refrigerator or freezer.)

Do I need to be a CBPU customer to receive the incentive?

Answer: Yes. In order to receive the incentive, you must be a CBPU residential electric customer.

Does my appliance need to be working?

Answer: Yes. Appliances must be operable to qualify for the program. Refrigerators and stand-alone freezers must measure between 10 and 30 cubic feet using inside measurements.

What time can I call to schedule a pick up?

Answer: Our call center is open from 8:00am to 5:00pm Monday through Friday - 866.341.8729.

What days are available for pickups?

Answer: 1 to 2 Wednesdays each month.

Who comes to pick up my appliance?

Answer: Two representatives from CBPU's contractor will come to your home and pick-up your appliance.

Do I need to help load my appliance onto the truck?

Answer: No. The representatives will take care of all loading responsibilities for your appliance.

Is there anything I need to do to prepare for the pickup?

Answer: Yes. Customers must empty out the unit that is being picked up and clear space around the unit so that it can be easily moved out of their home. There must be a person over the age of 18 present at the time of pick up. We will ask for verification of the customer's CBPU account number at the time of pick up and a signed release form verifying that the unit is operable.

How to I receive my incentive?

Answer: Your rebate check will be mailed to your home within 4 weeks of pick up.
